The Permittee acknowledges that Lincoln County, through its Board of Commissioners, has full control of the rights-of-way and ditches for the full extent of the width of the right-of-way. The Permittee shall acquire no ownership interest in any part of the right-of-way and shall exercise limited use of the right-of-way as granted by this Permit, and is subject to Lincoln County's superior position in the management of the right-of-way in the best interests of the citizens of Lincoln County.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD that the Permittee will cause the installation at no expense whatsoever to Lincoln County, and that the Permittee will own and maintain the same after installation.

The Permittee shall notify the adjoining landowners as to the Permittee's impending use of the right-of-way, which notification shall include a certified letter to the record owner of the property. Such notification shall be made at least five (5) days prior to any intended excavation or installation in the right-of-way. To the extent practicable, the Permittee shall cooperate with adjoining landowners so as to install the utility with a minimum of disruption to the landowner's ingress and egress to the landowner's property.

The Permittee shall maintain the installation at all times and agrees to hold Lincoln County, it's agencies, their officers, and employees harmless from any and all loss and damage which may arise out of, or be connected with Permittee's installation, maintenance, alteration, removal, or presence of the installation herein referred to, and any work or facility connected therewith, within the area covered by this permit. The Permittee is also responsible for placing "Advance Warning" signs. These signs should warn motorists of the construction activities and be placed far enough in advance of the work being conducted to provide adequate warning.

Permittee shall temporarily suspend construction, installation and/or maintenance of the installation upon receipt of a written request from Lincoln County if Permittee's construction, installation, and / or maintenance of the installation unreasonably interferes with Lincoln County's road construction and maintenance operations in the area of the installation.

In the event that any changes are made in the roadway at any time in the future that would require or necessitate the removal or relocation of this installation, the Permittee will promptly perform such removal or relocation at its own expense upon receipt of a written request from Lincoln County. Lincoln County shall not be responsible for any damage to the installation that may result from Lincoln County's maintenance of its roadway.

## SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

- 1. Fifty-four (54) Inches deep under county roads. Forty-eight (48) inches deep in roadway easements.
- 2. Return county road to existing condition.
- 3. Compact all roadway cuts in six (6) inch lifts.
- 4. Notify County Road Foreman twenty-four (24) to forty-eight (48) hours in advance of cutting through a county road.
- 5. The County Road Foreman will inspect the roadway cuts for a period of up to six (6) months. If any problems are detected in the roadway cut the Installer will be held liable for any repairs to the county road to the extent caused by the roadway cuts. The repairs could include all of the following: equipment (hours), materials, and man hours.
